

National Head Coach Women's Artistic Gymnastics

Full time position

The Norwegian Gymnastics Federation has approximately 100.000 members and is Norway's oldest Sports Federation. The federation organizes Gymnastics for All and competitions within WAG, MAG, RG, as well as Wheel Gymnastics and TeamGym. The head office is located in Oslo.

Responsibility

The national head coach is superior responsible for the top sports and the national teams within the activity. The national head coach keeps the committee, head of department and the Olympiatoppen updated within their areas of responsibility. In cases that are under the national head coach defined responsibility, he / she has decision-making authority alone.

Tasks

Together with the rest of your team, you will be instrumental in the further development of Norwegian Women's Artistic Gymnastics through planning and implementation of training and competitions for our best gymnasts. Possible task will be:

- Superior responsible for the top sport activity within the activity.
- Responsible for preparation, follow up and evaluation of the top sports planning and preparing the budget for the national team activity.
- Determine criteria for representation on national teams and participation in international competitions and championships.
- Making the selection of athletes and coaches for national teams and representation tasks.
- Responsible for the national teams activity.
- Keep up to date with developments in your field.
- Collaborate with other organizational members and other national head coaches in the department.
- Contribute to the continuous development of the current national team model for one's own activity as well as contribute with professional input to other sports top sports model.
- Contact with Olympiatoppen within one's own activity.

The work will have to be done according with the values within Norwegian Sports.

Qualifications

We require experience and competence on international level within Women's Artistic Gymnatics. We require experience within developing gymnasts to international top level. You must have a documented relevant and updated Sports education with a focus on Women's Artistic Gymnatics. You must speak and write English fluently.




Travelling
