



Oslo Turnforening would like to invite you to take part in the Trophies of Unni and Harald. This is the 25th international trophy since 1994 where our former national and international gymnasts Unni Holmen and Harald Wigaard have the pleasure to invite you to Norway's only international competition for WAG and MAG. The 2020 competition will take place in Oslo the 13th – 15st of March 2020.

Participation:

Each federation/club may participate with team juniors and seniors men and women (5-5-3). We will also invite youth gymnasts from Nordic countries to an individual competition Friday 13th of March. The Junior and Senior gymnasts will be scored by FIG - regulation, while the Youth will be scored by Junior FIG regulation.

The six gymnasts with the highest score in the different apparatus in the Junior and Senior competition, will qualify for the apparatus finales.

Each team can consist of both junior and senior gymnasts.

Competition format (according to the FIG Code of Point):

Friday: March 13th: Youth individual all-around competition Saturday: March 14th: Junior - Senior team and individual all-around competition Sunday: March 15^t: Apparatus finals Junior and Senior.

Number of judges and appointments

Each participating club is obligated to bring one judge for WAG and one judge for MAG if they have 2 or more gymnasts. 2-5 gymnasts= 1 judge, 6-10 gymnasts = 2 judges. All D - judges should be holders of the FIG license for the corresponding cycle. The participating club is responsible for all the economic expanses regarding judges. They are also responsible for booking travel, accommodations and meals for the judges. The organizer will provide food on the judges' tables. The appointment of judges to the apparatus will be made by the organizers.

All international clubs are obliged to bring one judge pr. team (if 2 or more gymnasts). If a team fails to bring a judge, there will be a fee of NOK 4000, -

The participation federations/clubs must pay all costs regarding traveling, accommodation, judges, and additional gymnasts by themselves. Payments must be prepaid to Oslo Turnforening within February 1st, 2020.

We kindly ask all international clubs to pay 50 NOK / 5 EURO in transaction fee.

Travel schedule and local transports

We recommend the delegations who arrives at Oslo Airport Gardermoen, to use the Airport Express – Bus FB3 which you will find on the platform outside the terminal. The bus will take you directly to Quality Hotel 33. Quality Hotel 33 offer their discounts on the Airport Express Bus for their hotel guests. A voucher will be sent out to all the participating clubs staying at Quality Hotel 33 after the registration- deadline.

Oslo Turnforening will offer transportation directly from the Competition Arena to Oslo Airport Gardermoen after the competition Sunday for 200 NOK per person. This must be pre-ordered in the registration form and payed for to the organizing club.

There will also be a shuttle bus between hotel 33 and the Competition Arena, Haslehallen the whole weekend. Must be ordered in the registration form and pre-payed.
