March 7th-8th 2020

Place

Competition area

Unlimited ceiling height, beige FIG-approved competition carpet, 2-3 extra carpets in a adjacent hall.









Preliminary schedule

Friday March 6th

Training in competition hall. I hour per nation on competition floor. Schedule will come later.

Technical meeting 20.00 in Kristianstad Arena.

Judge's meeting 21.00 in Kristianstad Arena.

Saturday March 7th

Training on competition floor 30 minutes per nation before competition.

Junior, individual - team competition and individual AA (rope, ball, clubs, ribbon).

Senior, individual - team competition and individual AA (hoop, ball, clubs, ribbon).

Junior, group - AA (5 ribbons, 2 rounds).

Senior, group - AA (5 hoops, 2 ropes and 3 balls).

Junior, duo/trio - apparatus by choice AA two rounds.

Senior, duo/trio - apparatus by choice AA two rounds.

Rules for the competition

The all-around competition for juniors and seniors will include the four apparatuses stated above. Each nation can participate with teams in both the junior class and the senior class. Each team may consist of 5 gymnasts, with 4 gymnasts/apparatus. The 3 highest scores in every apparatus are added together for the team competition.

The 6 best gymnasts in each apparatus (maximum 2 from each nation) will qualify for the individual apparatus finals.

Duo/trio will compete together in one category. The all-around for duo/trio will include two programs.

The all-around for the groups will include two programs. Maximum one group from each nation will qualify for the apparatus finals. The best group in the senior competition qualifies for the apparatus finals per apparatus (maximum 1 from each nation).

The entire competition follows the FIG:s Code of Points and the Nordic Code of Points for duos/trios.

Judges

Each nation is expected to provide 3 judges. A FIG judging brevet is recommended for judging Nordic Championships.

Technical meeting

The technical meeting is held in a meeting room in Kristianstad Arena March 6th, 20.00. Maximum 5 from each delegation.

A basic evening meal is served.

Judge's meeting

The judge meeting is held in a meeting room in Kristianstad Arena March 6th, 21.00. Each judge that will officiate at the championships is requested to attend. Coffee and "fika" will be served.

Accreditation

We will have the accreditation in the entrance to the competition hall on Friday between 14.30-17.30 and Saturday between 8.30-9.30. This applies to the gymnasts, coaches and physiotherapists. We will also look at the gymnasts passports.

Insurance

All delegation members must have a valid insurance for illness and accidents. Gymnasts also need a valid national passport, according to the Nordic technical regulations.

Flag and national anthem

All delegations must bring their own flag and national anthem on USB or CD.

To Kristianstad

You can travel to Kristianstad by car, bus, train or airplane. There are good connections by train to and from Copenhagen airport. There are also good connections to and from Malmö by train and bus. A timetable is available at https://www.skanetrafiken.se.



It is 1,5 kilometers from Kristianstad Central Station to the competition hall and a few hundred meters to the hotels.

Between the hotels and the competition hall it is about 1,5 kilometers and it takes about 20 minutes to walk. The green bus nr 3 is available close to the hotels and has a station next to Kristianstad Arena.
