Full time position

The Norwegian Gymnastics Federation has more than 107.000 members and is Norway's oldest Sports Federation. The federation organizes Gymnastics for All and competitions within MAG, WAG, RG, as well as Wheel Gymnastics and TeamGym. The head office is located in Oslo.

Organization:

The National Head Coach You will be responsible for the total work within the MAG on the national level in Norway and at the same time be in close cooperation with the local coaches, the Technical Committee MAG and the other parts of the National team. The National Head coach will also work closely with other parties such as physiotherapist, medical and administrative personnel, and the Norwegian Top Sport organization.

Tasks

Together with the rest of your team, you will be instrumental in the further development of Norwegian Men's Artistic Gymnastics through planning and implementation of training and competitions for our best gymnasts. Possible task will be:

- Responsible for planning and implementation of the gymnasts daily training in the national center.
- Responsible for national coach(es).
- Follow up the local clubs on a regular basis and oversee that the local coaches follow the plans.
- Participate in the development of the top sport model and culture within Men's Artistic Gymnastics in Norway.
- Participate in the development of the yearly plans and budget.

The work will have to be done according with the values within Norwegian Sports.

Qualifications

We require experience and competence on international level within Men's Artistic Gymnastics.

We require experience within developing gymnasts to international top level.

You must have a documented relevant and updated Sports education with a focus on Men's Artistic Gymnastics.

You must speak and write English fluently.

You must have a positive attitude, and you have to be able to work in a team with the other coaches. We also require an ability to work systematically and document the work digitally. You must be competent within communication with various actors within the sport, i.e. club coaches, club leaders, judges and national and international colleagues.

Travelling

There will be some travelling to training camps club visits and club visits in different places in Norway. You will also travel to national and international competitions and Championships.

Salary

The salary will be according to our policies.

The position will be available from 1st of September 2021. The position will be valid for 3 years, with a possible extension for 4 new years.
