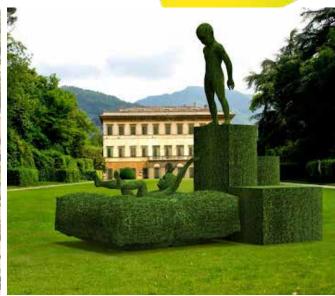
Nurserymen, landscapers and architects from all over the world come to Pistoia to see and choose plants that are placed at the entrance to the Louvre Museum as well as in the gardens of Buckingham Palace, at the Olympic stadium in Baku and at the court of the King of Jordan.

The history of Pistoia's nurseries has its roots in the 17th century, when local agriculture began to specialize in the cultivation of ornamental and garden plants. During the nineteenth century, thanks to the growing demand for trees and shrubs for aristocratic villas and gardens, the sector experienced significant expansion. However, it was in the twentieth century that Pistoia's nurseries established themselves as national excellence, with



the introduction of modern cultivation techniques and a progressive orientation towards the international market. Today Pistoia is considered the Italian capital of nursery farming, with thousands of cultivated hectares and an economy based on innovation and sustainability. The Pistoia nurseries export plants all over the world, contributing to the enhancement of urban greenery and the protection of the environment.







PISTOIATHE PLACE TO BE IN SUMMER 2026

In 2017 Pistoia
was named Italian
Capital of Culture,
a recognition
that enhanced its
extraordinary historical,
artistic and cultural
heritage. During the year,

the city hosted numerous events, exhibitions and initiatives that highlighted its identity, from medieval tradition to contemporary art.

The title has allowed us to rediscover symbolic places such as Piazza del Duomo, the Ospedale

del Ceppo, the Fabroniana Library and the Pistoia Sotterranea, as well as promoting important festivals such as the Pistoia Blues and the Dialogues on Man.

The event also encouraged tourism and the valorisation of the territory, strengthening the link between culture and economic development.

Even today, the legacy of Pistoia Capital of Culture 2017 is reflected in the cultural liveliness of the city, which continues to be a point of reference for art, music and literature in Tuscany and Italy.



PISTOIAWHAT TO SEE (MAIN ATTRACTIONS)

Pistoia offers a mix of cultural, historical and sporting attractions that make it a fascinating destination for visitors and residents.

Piazza del Duomo - The historic heart of the city, surrounded by medieval buildings such as the Cathedral of San Zeno, the Baptistery of San Giovanni in Corte and the Palazzo dei Vescovi.

Ospedale del Ceppo – Famous for the Della Robbia frieze in polychrome ceramic, which depicts scenes of hospital life.

Church of San Bartolomeo in Pantano and Church of San Giovanni Fuorcivitas - Treasures of Pistoia Romanesque art.

Fortezza Santa Barbara - Built by the Medici, today it hosts events and shows.

Civic Museum and Palazzo Fabroni - They house important art collections and contemporary exhibitions.

Pistoia Underground - A fascinating journey beneath the city that traces its history through tunnels and ancient buildings.

San Giorgio Library - One of the most modern and active libraries in Tuscany, with numerous cultural initiatives.

Cultural events - The Pistoia Blues Festival, which attracts internationally renowned artists, and the anthropology festival Dialoghi sull'Uomo.

Pistoia combines history, art and sport in a lively context, offering attractions for all tastes.









WHAT IS **EUROPEAN GYM FOR LIFE CHALLENGE**5TH EDITION

The EUROPEAN GYM FOR LIFE CHALLENGE is organized by European Gymnastics and is held every two years the days before Eurogym.

The EUROPEAN GYM FOR LIFE CHALLENGE will last for 1-3 days, depending on the number of groups. The Challenge is open for everyone from 12 years old and older.

Because of the high numbers of groups in the notification of interest, it was decided to plan with 3 days for Pistoia 2026 - rehearsal and contest days: Thursday 9 July, Friday 10 July and Saturday 11 July.

The TC-GFA and the LOC can take a random test during the event, and if there are participants younger than 12 years old, the group can be disqualified.

Groups consisting of a minimum of 6 gymnasts can participate in this gymnastics for all event and have their program evaluated.

The aim is to improve the quality of group performances by giving an evaluation and feedback,

including advice on how to improve.

The duration of the performance can be max. 5 minutes.

Each performance will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Entertainment value and overall impression
- Innovation and originality
- Technique, quality and safety
- Variety and diversity

The evaluation will be carried out by a panel of 4 experts who are experienced in the fields of performance, artistry, technique and choreography.

Feedback will be given directly to the coach by a skilled choreographer.

ABOUT THE EUROPEAN GYM FOR LIFE CHALLENGE PERFORMANCES

The groups present a performance of a maximum of 5 minutes. This is the maximum performance time, entry and exit is not included. The music must not exceed 5:00 mins.

If large apparatus are used, the group may use one minute for placing and removing the equipment.

This minute is to be without music and is used ONLY for moving the equipment/apparatus. It is not considered part of the performance.

The music must be delivered to the LOC two months in advance in order to be checked for quality and duration.

All groups will get rehearsal time. The rehearsal time for each group depends on the number of groups taking part.

The Contest will take place indoor with a performance area of 20 x 30 meters in total.

CATEGORIES

The main objective of the EUROPEAN GYM FOR LIFE CHALLENGE is to improve the quality of performances.

The TC-GFA focuses on the "show effect" which means attractiveness for the spectators.

The number of categories depends on the number

of groups participants to EUROPEAN GYM FOR LIFE CHALLENGE.

The TC-GFA can change the format of categories depending on the number of registrations (e.g. large groups/small groups, etc. with or without apparatus).

EVALUATION

Each performance will be evaluated according to the following criteria:

- Entertainment value and overall impression
- · Innovation and originality
- Technique, quality and safety
- · Variety and diversity

All parts have equal value, up to 5 points per criteria.

The evaluation will be carried out by a panel of 4 experts who are experienced in the fields of performance, artistry, technique and choreography.

This panel is invited by the TC-GFA.

The Evaluators will be directed by a supervisor before, during and after the event.

The supervisor is appointed by the TC-GFA. Each Evaluator has a total of 20 points, 5 per criteria.

After each performance the Evaluators give the 4 scores/criteria and the total score.

All scores are given independently. The 4 scores are added (max. score is therefore 80).



FEEDBACK

The Contest will have a minimum of 3 Feedbackers, who must be experienced in choreography.

The experts giving feedback will be appointed by the TC- GfA.

The feedback includes positive points from the performance and recommendations on how the performance can be improved.

The feedback will only be given to a coach or a choreographer.

Each coach/choreographer will meet the Feedbacker in a place indicated at the Coaches/ Head of Delegation meeting.

RESULTS

The scores will be used to establish an internal ranking list which will not be distributed.

All groups receive a trophy, all gymnasts receive a medal and a diploma.

European Gymnastics will also hand out some special diplomas.

The results will be announced and the prizes will be handed out after the Contest.

INCLUSION

We are committed to prioritizing the inclusion of all gymnasts, regardless of ability or level of function. To support this, we are actively working to accommodate athletes with special needs.

Quiet rooms will be available in areas where large crowds or long waits are expected, providing a calm and comfortable environment when needed. In addition, we can assist with alternative accommodation options and arrange volunteers to help with logistics, ensuring that every participant has the support needed to fully enjoy the event.

EUROPEAN GYM FOR LIFE CHALLENGE VENUE

The European Gym for Life Challenge will take place in PALA CARRARA (performance area 20×30 m, floor of oak, the ceiling is arched, 21,50 m high in the centre, 17 m high at the outer sides).

Passageway to access the gym floor is $2.37 \, \text{m}$ wide x $2.30 \, \text{m}$ high.

Passageway (opening door) to access the facility from outside: 3.00 m wide x 2.95 m high.

ACCOMMODATION SCHOOLS

The participants will be accommodated in schools near or in the city centre, from which they can easily reach all the event venues.

Even though Pistoia is a very safe city, all the schools will have 24 hour security.

The schools will be cleaned every day.

Each Head of Delegation is responsible for the conditions of the school where their groups stay.

It is forbidden to consume alcohol and drugs in schools grounds.

Not following the rules will have consequences.

The accreditation card will be withdrawn and the Head of Delegation is then responsible for finding a hotel room or the first flight home for the person not following the rules.

There will be clear information at the schools regarding safety and routines, and there will be an information meeting with the group leaders from each group as soon as everyone has arrived.

All participants must bring their own sleeping mattress and sleeping bag.

It will be possible to buy mattresses, blankets and pillows. More information on the next pages.

REGISTRATION DEADLINES EUROPEAN GYM FOR LIFE CHALLENGE 2026

PROVISIONAL REGISTRATION JULY 13TH - NOVEMBER 13TH 2025

For the provisional registration we will ask how many groups will attend from each Federation, and how many participants there will be in each group. 10% of the participation card should be paid by December 13th, this is non-refundable.

DEFINITIVE REGISTRATION NOVEMBER 13TH 2025 - MARCH 13TH 2026

For the definitive registration the LOC will ask for a lot of details about the participants (personal but not sensitive information), travel plans, special food, diet etc.

PAYMENTS

- 10% OF THE PARTICIPATION CARD SHOULD BE PAID BY DECEMBER 13TH, THIS IS NON-REFUNDABLE.
- THE REMAINING 90% FOR THE PARTICIPATION SHOULD BE FULLY PAID BY APRIL 13TH 2026.
- 50% REFUNDABLE UNTIL MAY 13TH, 2026.

INSURANCE

The Host Federation (FGI), the LOC and European Gymnastics shall not be held responsible for any liability in the event of accidents, illness, repatriation, or similar occurrences.

All participating groups are required to arrange their own valid insurance coverage for illness, accidents, repatriation, and any related risks for all members of their delegation. The LOC will verify proof of insurance upon accreditation.

The Head of Delegation is responsible for ensuring that each group can present either an insurance certificate or a photocopy of a valid policy. Delegates without proof of insurance coverage will not be allowed to participate in the EUROPEAN GYM FOR LIFE CHALLENGE.

Insurance may be arranged through the participating federation's own provider or purchased in advance - or upon arrival - by the LOC at a cost of € 90,00 per person.

WEDNESDAY JULY 8TH 2026

The LOC and European Gymnastics provide important information during this meeting.
