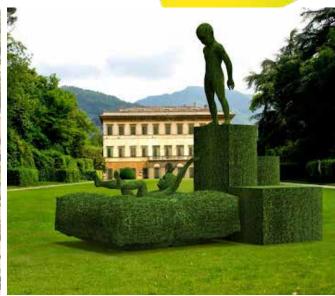
Nurserymen, landscapers and architects from all over the world come to Pistoia to see and choose plants that are placed at the entrance to the Louvre Museum as well as in the gardens of Buckingham Palace, at the Olympic stadium in Baku and at the court of the King of Jordan.

The history of Pistoia's nurseries has its roots in the 17th century, when local agriculture began to specialize in the cultivation of ornamental and garden plants. During the nineteenth century, thanks to the growing demand for trees and shrubs for aristocratic villas and gardens, the sector experienced significant expansion. However, it was in the twentieth century that Pistoia's nurseries established themselves as national excellence, with



the introduction of modern cultivation techniques and a progressive orientation towards the international market. Today Pistoia is considered the Italian capital of nursery farming, with thousands of cultivated hectares and an economy based on innovation and sustainability. The Pistoia nurseries export plants all over the world, contributing to the enhancement of urban greenery and the protection of the environment.







PISTOIATHE PLACE TO BE IN SUMMER 2026

In 2017 Pistoia
was named Italian
Capital of Culture,
a recognition
that enhanced its
extraordinary historical,
artistic and cultural
heritage. During the year,

the city hosted numerous events, exhibitions and initiatives that highlighted its identity, from medieval tradition to contemporary art.

The title has allowed us to rediscover symbolic places such as Piazza del Duomo, the Ospedale

del Ceppo, the Fabroniana Library and the Pistoia Sotterranea, as well as promoting important festivals such as the Pistoia Blues and the Dialogues on Man.

The event also encouraged tourism and the valorisation of the territory, strengthening the link between culture and economic development.

Even today, the legacy of Pistoia Capital of Culture 2017 is reflected in the cultural liveliness of the city, which continues to be a point of reference for art, music and literature in Tuscany and Italy.



PISTOIAWHAT TO SEE (MAIN ATTRACTIONS)

Pistoia offers a mix of cultural, historical and sporting attractions that make it a fascinating destination for visitors and residents.

Piazza del Duomo - The historic heart of the city, surrounded by medieval buildings such as the Cathedral of San Zeno, the Baptistery of San Giovanni in Corte and the Palazzo dei Vescovi.

Ospedale del Ceppo – Famous for the Della Robbia frieze in polychrome ceramic, which depicts scenes of hospital life.

Church of San Bartolomeo in Pantano and Church of San Giovanni Fuorcivitas - Treasures of Pistoia Romanesque art.

Fortezza Santa Barbara - Built by the Medici, today it hosts events and shows.

Civic Museum and Palazzo Fabroni - They house important art collections and contemporary exhibitions.

Pistoia Underground - A fascinating journey beneath the city that traces its history through tunnels and ancient buildings.

San Giorgio Library - One of the most modern and active libraries in Tuscany, with numerous cultural initiatives.

Cultural events - The Pistoia Blues Festival, which attracts internationally renowned artists, and the anthropology festival Dialoghi sull'Uomo.

Pistoia combines history, art and sport in a lively context, offering attractions for all tastes.









WHAT IS EUROGYM?

Eurogym is an international event that brings together young gymnasts from different European countries.

It is organized by European Gymnastics and is held every two years.

Eurogym is not a competition but rather a noncompetitive gymnastics festival that focuses on promoting the sport of gymnastics and fostering friendship and cultural exchange between young athletes from different countries.

The event typically includes gymnastics performances, workshops, cultural activities, and social events.

Eurogym is open to gymnasts between the ages of 12 and 18 who are members of European Gymnastics-affiliated national gymnastics federations.

The event is hosted by a different European city each time, with the host city responsible for organizing the various activities and providing accommodation and transportation for participants.

Overall, Eurogym is a great opportunity for young gymnasts to develop their skills, make new friends, and experience different cultures while promoting the sport of gymnastics at an international level.

EUROGYM GALA

EUROGYM Gala will take place in STADIO MARCELLO MELANI on July 16th. The performance area will be 20x20 m.

OPENING AND CLOSING CEREMONY

The parade for the Opening Ceremony will be through the streets of Pistoia, and will end at STADIO MARCELLO MELANI with an exceptional Opening Ceremony for EUROGYM 2026.

The Closing Ceremony will be held in the STADIO MARCELLO MELANI, and will be followed by a unforgettable farewell party.

CITY PERFORMANCES - GROUPS EXHIBITION

The city performances will take place at four different stages in the main squares of Pistoia's city centre, and give the groups the opportunity to show what they have prepared at home.

All performance levels are acceptable and everybody can participate.

Each group will present their performance twice during the week.

A group has to consist of minimum 6 gymnasts, and each performance can last a maximum of 5 minutes, excluding preparation of the venue and entry and exit are not included.

Participants can visit the stages in the morning, but there will be no opportunity for rehearsals on stages before the city performances.

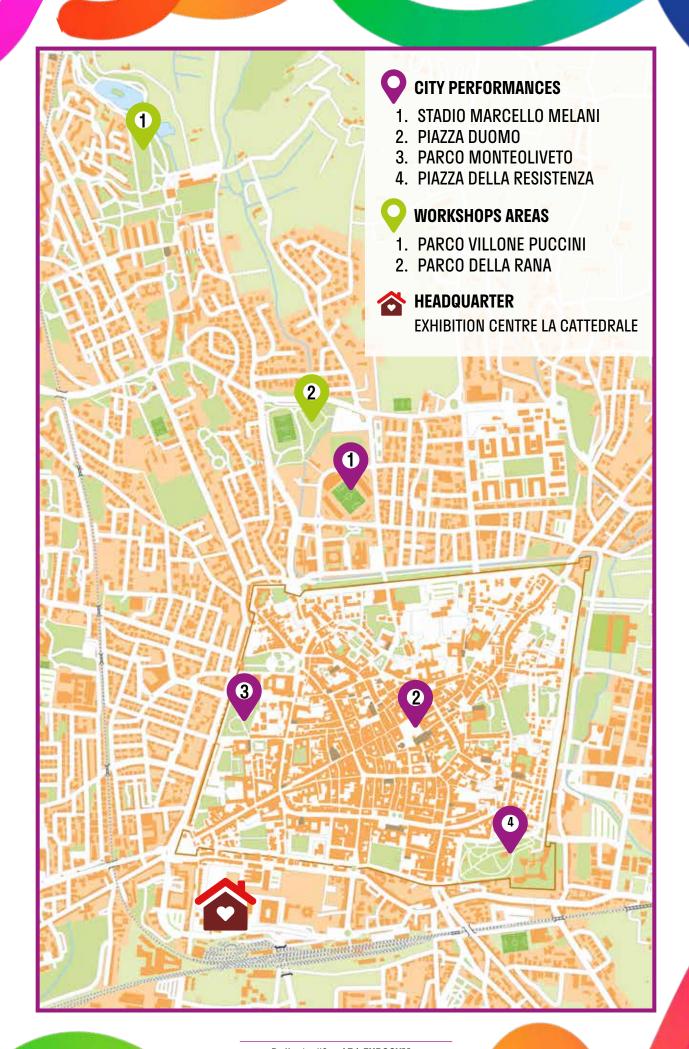

FROM SHAPE TO MEANING: THE BODY AS A TOOL FOR EMOTIONAL AND RELATIONAL COMMUNICATION.

The Educational Forum will be a dynamic and engaging learning experience, where coaches will exchange ideas and interact through fun motorplay activities and moments of shared reflection.

A unique opportunity to grow together while having fun, exploring the connections between body, mind, and the educational relationship.

We will invite some experts to address these issues in a dynamic way hoping to match your interest.

The Forum will have both a theoretical and a practical part.

The Forum will be led by Professor Andrea De Giorgio, kinesiologist and sport psychologist, and will focus on the use of the body as a tool to evoke emotions, making them conscious and manageable.

The Forum will take place in The City Hall and will offer an opportunity to return to that stage of life when we could only use our bodies to communicate with others.







WORKSHOPS

AERIAL DANCE

Silks and suspended hoops for an art form that combines athleticism and dance.



AEROBIC

Classic Aerobic Gymnastics creating varied and enjoyable routines.



ARCHERY

Develop concentration, control and stability through focused archery practice, while improving precision and coordination.



ARMOCROMIA

Activity dedicated to the relationship between sounds and colours to develop artistic sensitivity and multisensory perception.



ART OF GYMNASTICS

A basic gymnastics class that combines technique and creativity on some artistic gymnastics apparatus.







ATHLETICS

Run, jump and throw, experience the most classic of all sports disciplines.



BAREFOOT

A training session based on barefoot walking through Pistoia's parks, improving balance, body awareness and a natural connection with the ground.



BASIC ACROBATICS AND SAFE SPOTTING

Basic floor acrobatics, including exercises and activities in pairs and small groups, helps develop trust and confidence.



BASKET

Experience the excitement of basketball. Fast-paced and dynamic, this classic game combines skill, strategy and fun-filled challenges for all participants.



BLIND BASEBALL

An accessible version of baseball for visually impaired players, where the game relies on sound cues, teamwork and mutual trust.



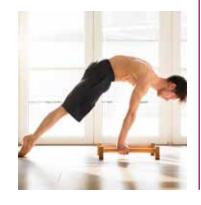
BREAK DANCE

An acrobatic urban dance style full of floorwork, power moves and creativity, symbolizing hip-hop culture.



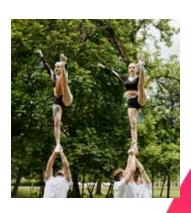
CALISTHENICS

CHEERLEADING

Let's have fun with Cheerleading, a highenergy activity that combines gymnastics, dance and acrobatics through stunts and dance routines.



CHOREOGRAPHY

Creation of a choreographic sequence, particularly suitable for artistic gymnastics routines.



CLASSICAL DANCE

A workshop experience based on technique, interpretation, and expressive body language, including barre, centre, floor work and short choreographies.



CONTEMPORARY DANCE

An expressive dance style blending classical and modern elements, focused on freedom of movement and personal interpretation.



COUNTRY DANCE

Group dancing to country music, featuring rhythmic steps, smiles and a strong sense of community.



CROSS TRAINING

Varied functional movement performed at high intensity, constantly challenging time, load and body.



FIELD HOCKEY

A team sport played on grass with sticks and a ball, developing coordination, speed and a competitive spirit.



FITBALL

Throws, rolls, bounces, dribbles, above, below and with the Fit-Ball.



FLAG POLE

An acrobatic discipline performed on a vertical pole, combining strength, control and creativity in suspended positions.







FLAG WAVING

The traditional art of flag handling, with rhythmic movements that unite technical skill and a sense of timing.



FUTSAL

An indoor version of football fast, technical, and requiring quick reflexes and strong teamwork.



GAG

A fitness workout focused on toning and strengthening the lower body: legs, abs and glutes.



HIKING

A brisk hike through nature, ideal for improving physical endurance and mental well-being.



HIP HOP

An energetic and stylized urban dance born as a form of free and creative self-expression in metropolitan cultures.



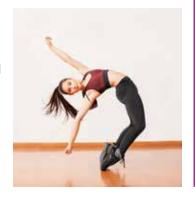
ITALIAN TRADITIONAL DANCE

A folkloric dance that celebrates regional Italian traditions through music, rhythm and social connection.



JAZZ DANCE

A lively and dynamic dance that combines technique, musicality and personal interpretation on jazz and pop rhythms.



JAZZ GYMNASTICS

A harmonious activity using pop music, alternating isolation and coordination exercises, spatial movements and a short final choreography.



JUDO

A Japanese martial art teaching discipline and respect through techniques of leverage, balance and controlled falls.



JUGGLING

Juggling practice that develops concentration, rhythm, and coordination using balls, clubs or rings in motion.



KARATE

A Japanese martial art based on precise strikes and self-control, strengthening body, mind and spirit.



LAUGHTER YOGA

A practice combining yogic breathing, guided laughter, and playful actions such as singing, playing, and dancing to promote well-being, energy and joy.



MAKE UP AND MOVE UP

Useful technical suggestions for creating makeup to enrich the scenographic aspects of choreography.



MODERN DANCE

Dancing as a way to explore new forms of free and personal expression.



MOUNTAIN BIKE

Cycling through the natural trails around Pistoia combining adventure, endurance, and connection with nature.



MOVE PLAY GROOVE

Discover how your body is the instrument, exploring rhythm, body percussion, and expressive motion in an explosion of energy and connection.







MOVEMENT AND EXPRESSIVENESS

"Pasitos" in male and female style, creating a short choreography focused on body expression.



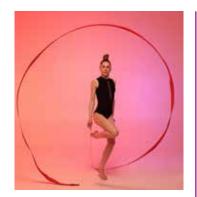
POSTURAL PILATES

RHYTHMIC GYMNASTICS

Basic elements of Rhythmic Gymnastics, performed both freehand and with apparatus.



RUGBY

An intense and strategic team sport that combines physical strength, teamwork and respect for the opponent.



SITTING VOLLEY

An inclusive seated version of volleyball that celebrates ability, teamwork, and connection, proving that sport has no limits.



SKATEBOARD

An urban sport based on balance and creativity, featuring tricks and evolutions performed on a wheeled board.



SKATING

Roller skating in its most classic form, focusing on balance, coordination and the joy of movement on wheels.



SLACKLINE

A balance activity performed on a flat webbing suspended between two points, designed to improve focus, stability and control.



SPECIAL CHOREOGRAPHY

Would you like instant feedback on your choreography? This workshop is for you! Perform your group choreography and receive tips and new suggestions.



STRENGTH AND POWER TRAINING

Functional training through the development of interval training with active recovery using bodyweight exercises and small equipment.





TAEKWONDO

A Korean martial art based on spectacular kicks and mental discipline, strengthening both body and character.



TENNIS

One of the most classic sports, practiced individually, in pairs or small groups.



ULTIMATE FRISBEE

A team game with a flying disc (Frisbee), combining running, precise throws, and fair play in a dynamic and friendly environment.



URBAN DANCE

Urban dances arise from the soul and cultural environment of people, representing a powerful artistic expression. Among them: hip-hop, afro dance, dancehall, voguing, waacking and many more.



URBAN WALKING

REGISTRATION DEADLINES EUROGYM 2026

PROVISIONAL REGISTRATION JULY 13TH - NOVEMBER 13TH 2025

For the provisional registration we will ask how many groups will attend from each Federation, and how many participants there will be in each group. 10% of the participation card should be paid by December 13th, this is non-refundable.

DEFINITIVE REGISTRATION NOVEMBER 13TH 2025 – MARCH 13TH 2026

For the definitive registration the LOC will ask for a lot of details about the participants (personal but not sensitive information), travel plans, special food, diet, etc.



PAYMENTS

- 10% OF THE PARTICIPATION CARD SHOULD BE PAID BY DECEMBER 13TH, THIS IS NON-REFUNDABLE.
- THE REMAINING 90% FOR THE PARTICIPATION SHOULD BE FULLY PAID BY APRIL 13TH 2026.
- 50% REFUNDABLE UNTIL MAY 13TH, 2026.

INSURANCE

The Host Federation (FGI), the LOC and European Gymnastics shall not be held responsible for any liability in the event of accidents, illness, repatriation, or similar occurrences.

All participating groups are required to arrange their own valid insurance coverage for illness, accidents, repatriation, and any related risks for all members of their delegation. The LOC will verify proof of insurance upon accreditation. The Head of Delegation is responsible for ensuring that each group can present either an insurance certificate or a photocopy of a valid policy. Delegates without proof of insurance coverage will not be allowed to participate in the EGFLC.

Insurance may be arranged through the participating federation's own provider or purchased in advance - or upon arrival - by the LOC at a cost of \$ 90,00 per person.
