Tromsø Turnforening (TTF) is seeking to appoint a Head Coach for our boys' and men's artistic gymnastics (MAG) programme, starting on 1 of January 2027 or as soon as possible thereafter. We are looking for a coach with experience and qualifications in high-level artistic gymnastics, as well as strong coaching skills. Competence in spotting and safety procedures is essential and mandatory.

The Head Coach of ATM will be expected to work closely with the club and its athletes to implement the club's strategies and contribute to the achievement of its ambitions and objectives. A detailed job description will be developed in consultation with TTF's management and ATM's Sports Manager.

TTF has strong ambitions and a long-standing tradition of excellence in men's artistic gymnastics. Therefore, we seek to appoint a Head Coach who shares these ambitions and who is committed to continuing this development of the men's programme.

International applicants are encouraged to apply. Applicants must be able to communicate in English or a Scandinavian language. In addition, the successful candidate must be willing to undertake a Norwegian language course in collaboration with the club.

Tasks

- Develop, implement, and evaluate long- and short-term plans for ATM in accordance with the club's strategy and ambitions, in collaboration with the ATM Sports Committee.
- Hold professional responsibility for the training and individual development of all gymnasts in the group, in cooperation with the coaching team.
- Assume overall responsibility for training within ATM.
- Plan and participate in competitions together with the gymnasts.
- Supervise and coordinate assistant coaches.
- Recruit new gymnasts from the club's open general classes.

- Positive, self-motivated, and committed to achieving results within a team environment.
- Qualifications and demonstrated experience in high-level artistic gymnastics.
- Strong competence in spotting and safely receiving gymnasts.
- Well-organised, structured, and focused.

- Excellent communication and collaboration skills, with the ability to work effectively with gymnasts, parents, coaches, and assistant coaches.

About the employer

Tromsø Turnforening (TTF) was founded in 1862 and is the oldest sports club in the North Calotte region. TTF has approximately 750 active members across recreational programmes, competitive groups, and other gymnastics activities. The majority of our members are children and young people participating in recreational gymnastics.

In 2018, the Tromsø Gymnastics Hall was completed at Templarheimen. The facility is wholly owned by Tromsø Turnforening and is fully equipped with gymnastics apparatus and pits. Today, the hall is operated by TTF employees and a dedicated group of volunteers. TTF has approximately 50 employees, including five permanent coaches working in various part-time positions and three permanent administrative staff members.

TTF is based in Tromsø, the largest city in Northern Norway, with approximately 80,000 inhabitants. Tromsø is Northern Norway's largest university town and attracts students from across Norway as well as from abroad. The city is renowned for its unique natural surroundings and spectacular location, attracting visitors throughout both the winter and summer seasons. Tromsø also offers a vibrant cultural and social scene, with a wide selection of restaurants, cafés, and bars.
